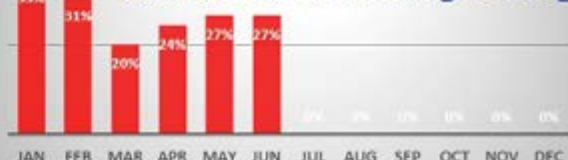

Brooklands Museum - by Keith

Basil asked me to write a short piece and send some pictures of my recent trip to the Brooklands Motor Museum while I was in England recently. I will also add some non-Brooklands bits and pieces, but not too many. The Brooklands Museum is not a slick highly sanitized place. It is situated in the surrounds of the old brick oval track, which has largely disappeared – you can see a bit of it, but are not allowed to walk on it. There are a whole lot of buildings of varying age and material in which the exhibits are kept. The old style “man in a shed” type workshops were interspersed between more modern buildings. It took me back to my childhood with examples of all kinds of British made vehicles, you won’t see any Ferrari’s or Lamborghi-ni’s.

Lots of British bikes, cars, trucks, old F1 cars, buses and aeroplanes are on display. Each shed/building has one or two people who are on hand to give information and explanations. We spent a long time sticking our noses into the assortment of buildings to find examples of cars and bikes we had forgotten. It was not all old bangers, there is a display of a McLaren GTR complete with a Lego life sized model of it which apparently took 2500 hours to build.



We had my brother-in-law's 5-year-old grandson in tow. He was more interested in the aeroplanes and buses than motor-bikes.



But enough of the cars there are some fantastic old, and not so old motorcycles

on display, so I will just let the pictures do the talking. I did not place any pictures in the article when I wrote it, but sent Basil the editor a variety of shots to use at his discretion.

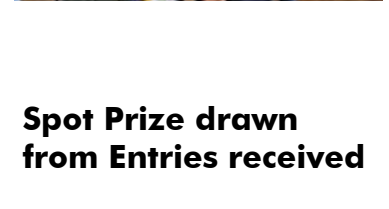

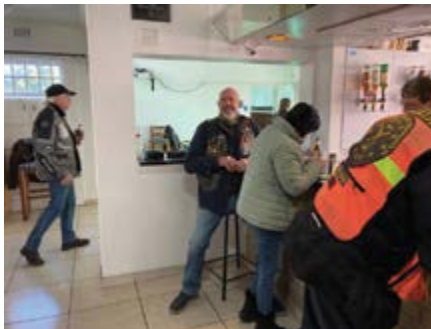
