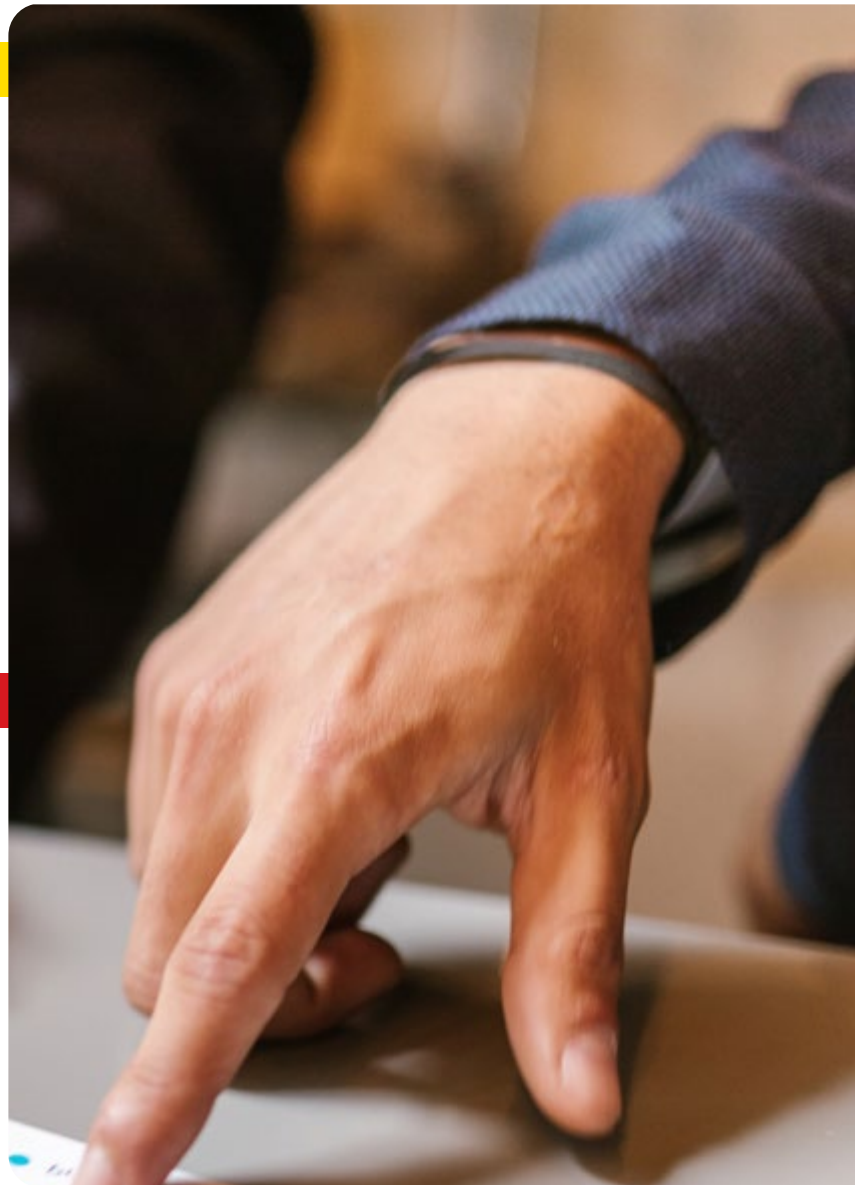

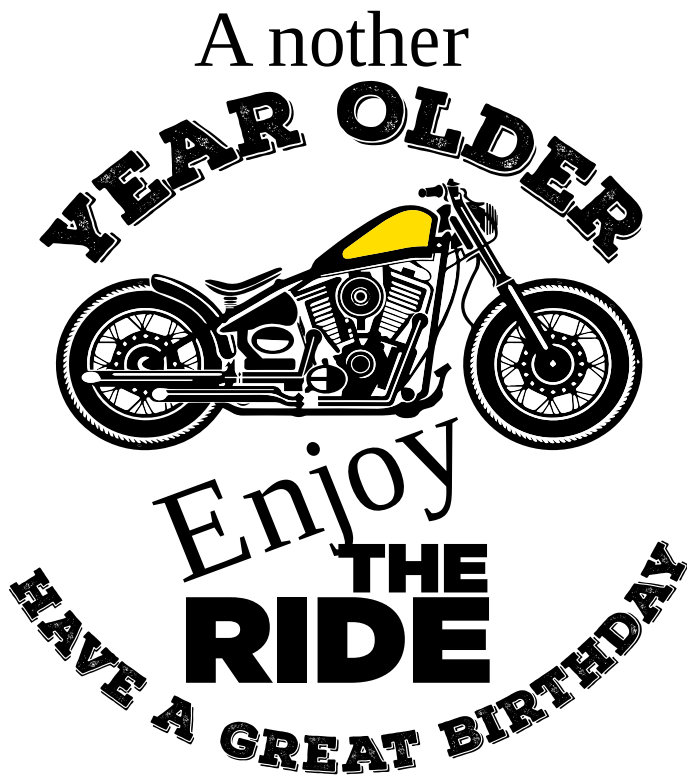

Motorcycle Track Day - it is open to riders of all makes of motorcycles who want to improve their riding skills up to a standard of excellence, rather than down to a speed limit.

It's not about speed, although the hotshots in the Fast Group enjoy riding very fast indeed. Even the most inexperienced riders in the Slow Group benefit immensely from riding around the circuit no faster than they would on suburban streets, repeating the same sequence of corners every two-and-a-half minutes and smoothing out their lines every time until precision steering becomes more a matter of muscle memory than conscious effort.

Riders will be seeded into three groups – Beginner, Medium and Fast. Full riding gear is required for all riders except those in the Beginner group, where basic gear is acceptable.

Always listening to Hector how the day at the track was and how he enjoyed it had to go look for myself. So after a much debated evening with my wife and should I go; should not go, dam weather was so cold and that really bugged the hell outa me.....

While he got in line for the take off we ran up-stairs to get a cup of coffee and watch him have a great RIDE!!! Hat off to you old man.



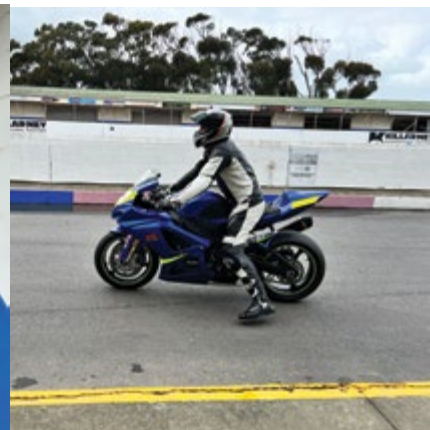

Haynes Story

HAYNESWHAT !!!! ????

Did you see that!..... What! Haynes!!! Who? Too late, we can visit on our return.

Ambling down the motorway, in England, heading for Devon, a brown sign board appeared with the word 'Haynes Motor Museum'. This is a legendary place, the place where a gentleman has stripped motor cars, and motor cycles to produce the famous HAYNES MANUAL used by many amateur car and motorcycle rebuilders as a bible to getting the rebuild done correctly.

A week later the GPS could not locate the Haynes Motor Museum, but dodgy route exploring revealed the hallowed place, and what a sight it was.

In 1954 whilst still at boarding school, a 16-year-old John H Haynes bought a worn-out Austen Seven and built his own 'Austen 750 Special'. As the project grew, he made notes and sketches of each stage of the construction. When he sold his '750 Special' he was amazed at how many inquiries he had.



He then used his notes to produce a booklet 'Building a 750 Special' and quickly sold the 250 copies he made at 5 shillings each. This was the very first Haynes Manual. Because of that little car, and some 200 million manuals later, the publishing empire John H Haynes OBE built, allowed him to follow his passion even further and in 1985 the Haynes International Motor Museum was born.

Make no mistake, the museum is well curated, and is very different to the standard boring motor museums. It is themed with red cars taking the main exhibition area. Then there are imitation British workshops of yore, and cubicles where volunteer mechanics are actively stripping and rebuilding cars. The audio-visual projections are impressive.

The collection of Mini's, the big Cadillacs, including an old Cadillac ambulance, a beautiful collection of Lotus cars, and many other British marques. The bike collection is all donated British bikes, from British competition riders, including their worn-out leathers, and damaged crash helmets. The Williams F1 display was phenomenal with a section dedicated to F1 driver safety, and so up to date is the display, that components of the Williams F1 crash in May 2022, were on display already.

But more to the point of my excitement of visiting the Haynes Motor Museum, was the fact that they produce Repair Manuals. An impressive sales section allows you to browse per category for what you want. There they were two Yamaha manuals that I needed, for my current rebuild projects. A delightful young lady, clued up on cars, motorcycles, and cash, assisted me with my purchase.



Browsing the shop, is an adventure, and you can easily be lured into buying more books just in case, the quality is so good, and the diverse assortment of books, from expensive cars to unimpressive runabouts are all catered for. There are hundreds of people that write the books, take photographs, and glean information from the original factory workshop manuals. That portion of the Haynes Museum is another story. Take a look at www.haynesmuseum.org



Very little gaudy tourist trinkets to buy, but a big selection of replica badges, clothing, and apparel was reasonably priced against the SA Rand.

An obligatory tea and scones was had in the "Café 750" and funny not surrounded by car memorabilia, but rather, like-minded people all buzzing about motor cars and motor cycles.

Whilst this is written in the singular form, I must admit that it was the first time my wife Penny, thoroughly enjoyed a motor museum, and she walked away with a lot of Land-rover memorabilia.

Haynes Story

My friend Black Label was in the "Café 750", but he decided to remain in the cool as the outside temp was 28C in England.
