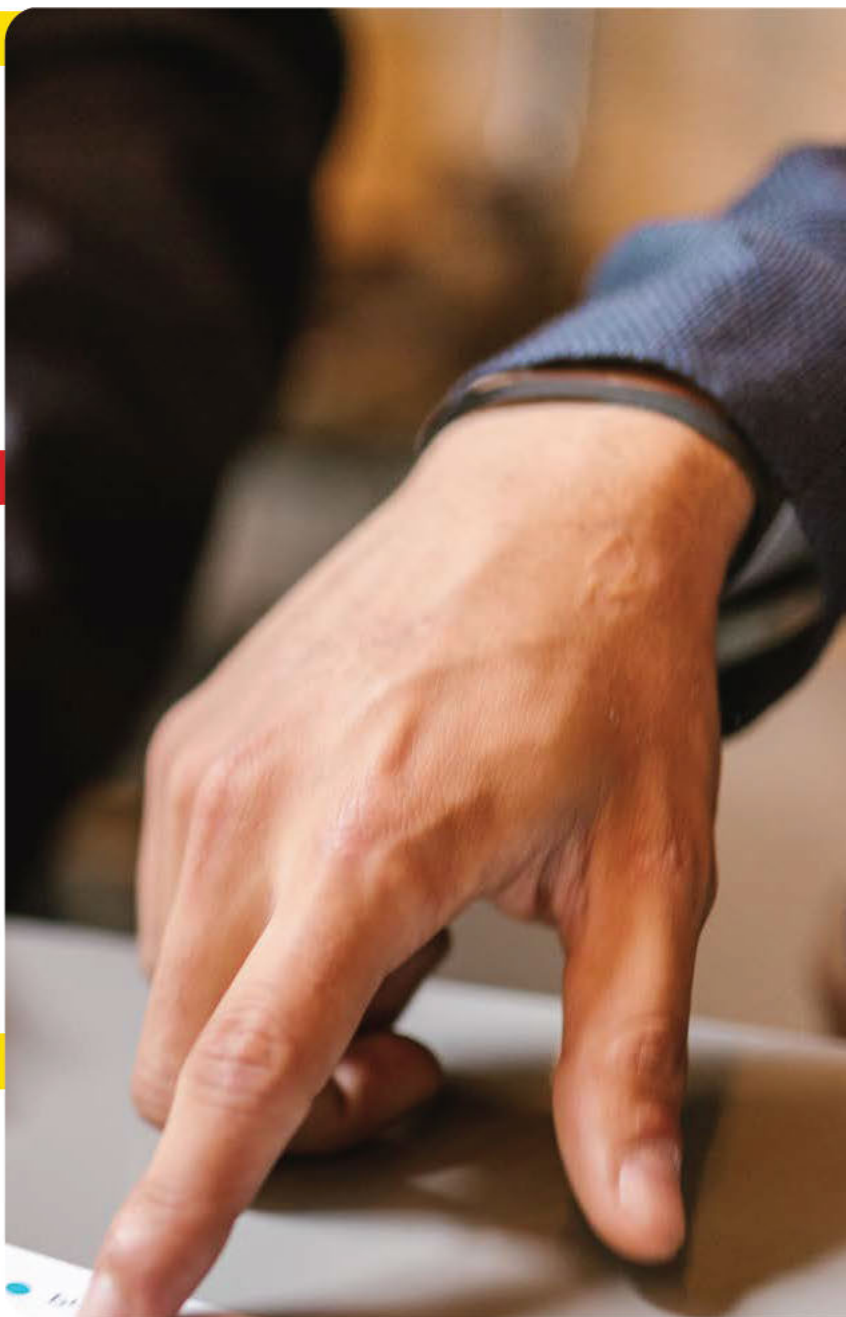

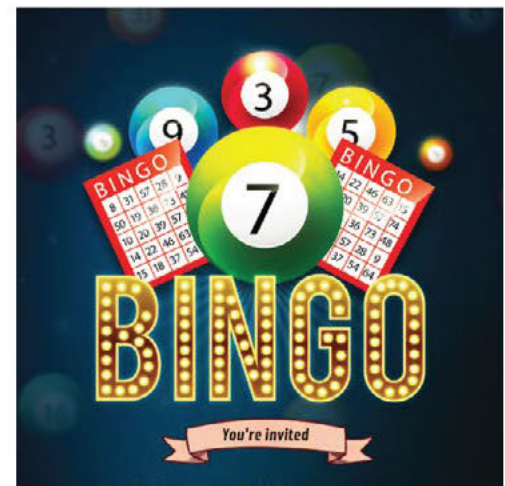

I was worried about my back giving me problems but luckily Norflex sorted that out for me. There was plenty of socializing around our campsite and

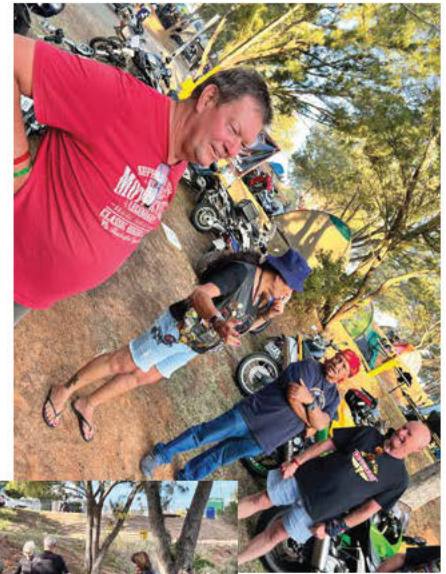
under the gazebo. Thanks again to Robbie and team for setting up the campsite and pitching the tents. As always it made such a big difference.

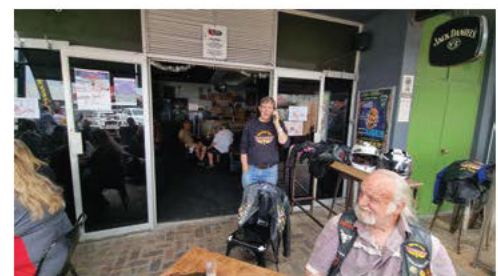
